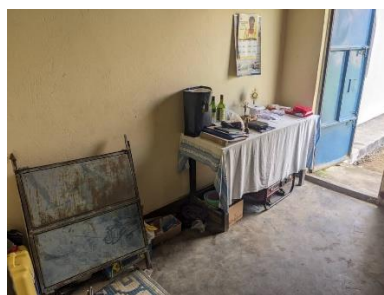
By providence we had volumes 1 and 2 but randomly, someone presented us with the third. These we sent with a first set of altar vessels and pyx.
