The southern part of the island has been hit by a massive drought and crops have failed. There are many needs here of various types. He approached us initially to help provide a hygienic eating place for children at the school. We will try to raise the \$6000.00 (or equivalent) and we are looking at ways to raise this money.

However he also asked for vestments, which we have now sent, and other altar items. But many more are needed. Patens and Ciboria are needed in all the projects.

If possible we will send medicines after we have verified customs regulations for Madagascar.
